### 4. President's Report

T. Thompson spoke about events this year in particular Julie's illness and subsequent passing and its effect on the CMC. He extended thanks to the whole committee for picking up the pieces. Terry spoke about each committee member's efforts in making things work within the CMC.

NMHD is always good with a wonderful range of places to display your vehicles. The Kurrajong event organised by the Magic Metal Motoring Club will be included in 2019.

SSC event was put together with assistance from Megan O'Donnell and her partner Alex and all the committee filling in where Julie had left off. This year a bigger crowd attended at SMSP and the ARDC were very happy with the event this year. Muscle Car Masters is being restructured and will move back to Father's Day.

HVS system being managed by T. Thompson – 27 HVS vehicles were reported to RMS because of irregularities. CVS is a huge job – numbers have gone from 1285 to 2410 in addition to 1386 renewals.

Vehicle Standards Working Group is an interesting group. T. Thompson was appointed to the Road Safety Advisory Council – unfortunately the NSW Police Officer sitting on the panel doesn't now give statistics.

Protection of Movable Cultural Heritage Act – 6 vehicles were given permission to leave the country because they don't fit the criteria of the Act of Australian Engineering History or had been involved with a significant event or significant driver.

The AHMF meeting was held in Adelaide in September – luxury car tax was discussed and is still in place. \$800M collected per year for the Govt. They're trying to have it repealed for vehicles over 30 years, provided they are brought in minus asbestos, which is being found in firewalls, hood linings, gaskets etc. There was a presentation about new rules for importing of vehicles. It would effectively be easier to import old cars. Include a 3500 ton GVM on those vehicles (25 year olds). Paperwork will be required and assurance that the vehicle won't be used for commercial purposes.

There were some problems with delegates at the beginning of the meeting. Sunday involved taking part in the Bay to Birdwood which was for pre-1961 cars. The SA Federation who commenced this event have been replaced by the SA Government. The 2019 AGM of the AHMF will be held in Melbourne.

AHMF this year was a successful event.

## 5. Treasurers Report

As tabled by K. De Luca, who outlined the CMC expenses for 2018 and advised delegates of the Income & expenditure for the year. The financials were again reviewed by Stewart Temesvary of Stanley & Stewart, Chartered Accountants. The Accounts ended in a surplus of \$6,195.78 for the 2018 year.
