Judging Pool - T. Bebbington

T. Bebbington reported that it's been a busy year. All clubs enjoy the independence of the CMC judging pool. Two new (younger) judges joined the Judging Pool this year. There has been difficulty with some venues and some have had to be cancelled.

Terry Thompson stated that we owe a big vote of thanks to the judging pool. <u>Carried</u>

National Motoring Heritage Day – 19th May 2019

T. Thompson advised the AHMF expressed gratitude for the way NSW conducts this event. There are flyers at the front table for the 2019 Berry Event. Venues will probably be the same as 2018.

Shannons Sydney Classic - 18th August 2019

T. De Luca advised that application forms for 2019 will be available at the January General Meeting and online at that time. He advised Clubs not to delay as space will be at a premium.

Anniversaries and club birthdays will need to be notified a.s.a.p. so that plans can be put in place.

It's possible that the maximum spaces per club on pit lane may have to be reduced to 3 or 4 as we need more space for Concours. The cut-off date will remain at 30th June. There will be changes in Area C.

This year was successful and next year will be even bigger.

T. Thompson thanked Tony De Luca and Allen Seymour for all their efforts. He advised that hopefully there will be a large amount of money spent at SMSP on lighting for night events. Construction work for this will be enormous and a lot of planning will be needed before starting it all.

AHMF & RSF

T. Thompson reported that the 2019 AGM will be held in Melbourne – more details in the AGM meeting following this. Jamie Tilley from Pittwater Motor Enthusiasts received a \$750 Grant from RSF.

ACMC & VSWG & Road Safety Advisory Council - T. O'Donnell

T. O'Donnell reported there may be another Motoring Enthusiast Conference early February 2019. Brake Assessment Manual is an issue – a rogue element is causing issues with RMS plus some interesting national issues including asbestos etc. Need to convey correct information rather than incorrect. RMS have been attending car shows and fining people who have H Plates illegally.

Vehicle Standards Working Group and Road Safety Council will meet sometime in December.

Events & Tours - L. Titcume

L. Titcume reported:

Classic Yass event held early in November was a great weekend. It's a growing event.

Albury Tour 22 March 2020 in conjunction with the AHMF Motoring Festival – travelling down the South Coast, across the Snowy Mountains then along the Murray River to Albury, stopping at a few towns on the way. AHMF National Motoring Festival will begin on 28/3/2020 through to 3/4/2020. Lynelle currently has 21 vehicles registered.

Europe/UK in 2021 – visiting Lamborghini, Ferrari, Mercedes, Renault, Maserati, National Auto Museum in Italy, Nurburgring, Paris/Rome/Venice/Salzburg etc – around 30 days. Expressions of interest being taken at the moment. Deposits will be taken in a few months' time.

Matters of Affiliation - L. Gough

L. Gough advised while no new clubs have applied for affiliation, he has been speaking with 2 clubs in the last week – North St. Mary's Car Club and Ye Old Car Club.

Not much else happening at the moment.

General Business

B. Adby spoke about what a great event the Yass Classic was. He then advised having interesting talks with NRMA Road Service people. As a petition was being contemplated the NRMA made contact. They aren't interested in driver cover, but may look at proposals for special categories for classic cars. Brochures indicate some changes might be coming. The Sub-Committee were thanked for their efforts.

HVS – NSW Police are looking at log books not being filled in and asking to see club membership card – fines will apply.

People are listing pictures on social media of cars on H plates with extreme modifications.

The Chev Club had an event where modified cars on H plates weren't accepted into the event.

Clubs don't have to check log books – it's up to the operator of the vehicle.

RAA SA Scheme – the owner is covered, another driver of that car needs to be registered with RAA. Further discussion ensued re Premium cover/driver/car cover.

John McCoy-Lancaster congratulated CMC/ACMC – also mentioned NMHD 19/05/19 at Kurrajong – all welcome.

RMS have been asked about an extension on the CVS scheme but nothing to hand.

Acronyms which may appear in the report are explained as follows:

ACMC - Australian Confederation of Motor Clubs

A group of 8 motoring enthusiast councils etc. representing most areas of classic motoring. The ACMC was formed to fill the need for motoring enthusiasts to have a combined, and therefore stronger, voice when dealing with Government Departments in relation to the motoring enthusiast movement. ACMC is the signatory to the MoU for the CVS.

AHMF - Australian Historic Motoring Federation

National peak body for historic motoring enthusiasts

ANSMA - Australian National Street Machine Association

Peak body for street machines.

ASIC - Australian Securities & Investments Commission

Enforces company and financial services laws to protect consumers, investors and creditors; regulates and informs the public on these matters.

ASRF - Australian Street Rod Federation

Peak body for street (hot) rods.

CVS - Classic Vehicle Scheme

Conditional registration for modified vehicles 30 years old and older. Contains a 60-day logbook option.

HVS (Old HCRS) - **Historic Vehicle Scheme** Conditional registration for unmodified vehicles 30 years old and older. Contains a 60-day logbook option.

NMHD - National Motoring Heritage Day

An initiative of the AHMF whereby motoring enthusiasts are encouraged to be out on the roads and attending various events around the country, in order to keep the interest in our vehicles alive and thriving. NSW leads the way in this event.

RSF - Robert Shannon Foundation

A foundation dedicated to assisting motor vehicle restoration and other related projects, (for under 30-year old club members) by way of annual grants.

RSAC - Road Safety Advisory Council

SSC - Shannons Sydney Classic

The CMC's premier event; held in August each year at Sydney Motorsport Park for clubs to display their vehicles and compete for Concours trophies.

SMSP - Sydney Motorsport Park

SSC main event venue.

VSWG - Vehicle Standards Working Group

Came out of discussions by the ACMC with the NSW State Government, which then formed the group to assist with motoring standards for classic vehicles. The ACMC and CMC are well represented on this panel.
