CVS Update: We will have over 5000 cars on CVS registration by the end of the week.

HVS has reached over 56000 vehicles.

- Terry reminded all those clubs with CVS vehicles, that they MUST be affiliated by 31st December to maintain CVS registration.

Judging Pool: Terry Bebbington

Nothing to report, not expecting anything for this year due to Covid restrictions.

NMHD:

Suggested date is 16th May 2021, we were awaiting consensus from other states. CMC has confirmed that NSW will hold NMHD on 16th May 2021.

Shannons Sydney Classic SSC: T. Thompson / Tony O'Donnell / Karen & Boyd Symington

- * Awaiting confirmation on our requested dates for next year, 14th-15th August 2021. ARDC are still in discussions with Supercars for their dates.
- * 116 Light towers have been added to the SMP track, enabling more use of the facility at night. Terry informed us that there is a good GoPro video of a racer on the SMP track, and urged members to take a look.
- * For those clubs that had paid for their SSC tickets for 2020, Medallions have been bagged, and were available for collection in the break. For anyone who would like to purchase a 2020 medallion, they were available for \$5.00 each.

AHMF & RSF: Terry Thompson

AHMF:

- * AHMF has held 2 meetings via teleconference.
- * FIVA Surveys continue to be send out to clubs. CMC feels they are not applicable for us.
- * AGM has been rescheduled in the ACT, for 18th & 19th September 2021. NSW will host the 2022 AGM.
- * Luxury Vehicle Tax debate is on hold at the moment.
- * AHMF Rally, was cancelled due to Covid, they are now going to hold a smaller version in March 2021, utilizing the runs that had been planned. Those interested should speak with Lynelle.

RSF:

Robert Shannon Foundation is asking for submissions.

ACMC: Terry Thompson

- * Tony O'Donnell has resigned & stepped down as President of ACMC. Evan Jones has joined as our 2nd delegate.
- * There have been rule changes, inhouse squabbling, the AGM will be held this Saturday.
- Meeting with TfNSW, was poorly attended.
 - New Log Book (with a Monaro on the cover) should be starting distribution from December 7th. ONLY available when processing renewals.
 - TfNSW was discussing an Industry Dashboard, finally decided not feasible at present.
 - Parkes Service NSW- reprimanded over advertising they would process HVS papers via scan and email due to Covid.
 - GVM limit on conditional registration will not be removed. Discussions continue to raise to 4.5 upper limit.
 - TfNSW Club database, still needs to sort our procedures for new clubs requesting HVS.

- CVS number plate discussion on sizing, MY PLATES have said no, discussions continue.
- There had been a push to restrict HVS cars to their original colour- not going to happen.
- Feedback on DRAFT HVS list -Seat belts to be certified, certification has always been
 a legal requirement, clarification has been short on who can certify. Red blinking tail
 lights have never been legal in Australia. Discussions continue re CD players, pin
 striping, etc., etc. List is still DRAFT only at this point, and they have stated that the list
 will be reviewed yearly.
- Service NSW employees have been reported for making arbitrary decisions regarding
 if a vehicle is suitable for HVS.
- Many of the TfNSW HVS/CVS rules have been rewritten. CMC recommends that clubs go to the RMS website regularly to keep apprised of any changes.

Events and Tours: Lynelle Titcume

- * Nothing has been organized locally due to Covid.
- * Europe tour has been deferred for a couple of years.
- * Lynelle is unable to attend the March 2021 event in Albury, but is making available her original tour plans for the drive and stops travelling to Albury. Anyone interested, please speak to Lynelle.

Lester reported on 4 new Club applications—Lake Macquarie Classic Car Club Inc, Club Autohaus Historic and Exotic Car Club, NSW Historic Patrol Vehicles Inc, Extreme Muscle Cars Inc.
