Treasurer - K. De Luca

K. De Luca read and tabled the Financial Report for the period 24/11/20 to 1/02/21.

Tony O'Donnell reported that Pre purchased positions had been held over to this show.

New maps are being drawn for Area D, due to new changes at SMP.

Application Forms for SSC 2021 were available for collection during the break for those clubs that had not purchased tickets last year.

AHMF/RSF

Some school girls in Wenona School North Sydney have been working with their teacher on restoring a Morris Minor Low Light. The teacher has been contacted and given information re RSF grants. He is preparing a submission. CMC hopes to invite the Teacher, girls and car to a future SSC to display their efforts.

AHMF are planning another tele-meeting for Monday 8/2.

ACMC & VSWG & Road Safety Advisory Council - T. O'Donnell & T. Thompson

The AGM was held in a very hot shed at Razorback. T Thompson and E Jones confirmed as our reps.

Proportional voting was suggested but was not supported by some delegates.

Issues between delegates - passed a ruling that 75% of delegates must approve any new delegates proposed.

Concern over the Draft RMS rules, and proposed changes to eligibility of plant, trucks, etc.

T Thompson has put forward a revised proportional system for NSW ACMC Ltd, to be voted on at their next meeting.

Next meeting is Wednesday evening.

CVS – as of 2/2/21 there are 4882 vehicles on CVS.

Breakdown is - 2300 + NSW Historic Motoring - 1229 Street Machine - 950 CMC

- 324 Street Rod - 37 4WD - 18 ACT - 6 Drag Ends - 2 Motorcycle Council of NSW

There are over 56,000 vehicles on HVS.

RMS has been having Computer system glitches which has caused problems with Conditional Registration, most of the problems have been fixed.

Events & Tours - L. Titcume

Lynelle Titcume reported that not much has been happening at present.

8. MATTERS OF AFFILIATION - L. Gough

Lester Gough tabled extensive reports on the two Clubs for affiliation –

DBA Cruisers Inc, and Riverstone Historic Truck and Machinery Club Inc.

Lester recommended that the Clubs be accepted for CMC affiliation. The two clubs were voted on separately. Both clubs' votes were successful.

General Business:

Many questions have been asked re RMS and proposed changes. Terry Thompson reported on the HVS list that had been circulated, he has been informed that they are only guidelines, not rules.

Terry Thompson read out a statement issued on the 25/11/20 by Trevor Booth, an RMS contractor, re Plant and Agricultural Machinery, also mentioning Heavy and Military Vehicles.

On 1/2/21 he received a reply to inquiries:

"I have now heard back from our Policy team and am finally able to confirm that per the below on tractors/agricultural/plant vehicles, we continue to be in consultation and nothing has been finalised.

Please reiterate to your stakeholders that nothing has changed and wide consultations will be made with yourself and others in any circumstance that may impact them."

The Committee will continue to keep members informed of any changes we hear of. Noting that website info still needs to be corrected.

T Thompson noted that Robert Adby had resigned from the CMC Committee after the last Committee Meeting, also noting that he had stood down from other club positions. We thank him for his contributions and wish him well.

Terry Thompson also thanked Kay De Luca, and Karen Symington for their hard work, and efforts on behalf of the CMC.

John McCoy Lancaster spoke of a meeting he had attended, mentioning lots of movement and expansion in the new vehicles and truck market. There are new rules and changes with electric vehicles being discussed, and he thought CMC should consider a sub committee to look into this further.

Question re D-plates sizes, any progress? – RMS has been blaming MY PLATES, My PLATES says they cannot see a problem. It has been ongoing since 2016, <u>answer</u>-we keep going.

<u>HVS – non-compliant cars and reporting.</u> – RMS is looking at setting up a site where people can upload photos and information on non-compliant vehicles direct to them. Terry cautioned people to remember that we are now looking at 1991 vehicles being accepted on HVS, and that some of these vehicles period options/accessories included items that may not appear standard. Do your homework before reporting.

For CVS vehicles that have the older pre-electronic recorded Engineers Certificate, you will need to have the original or at least a copy, RMS may have a record of the number, but not any information, therefore there is no record regarding what modification(s) have been carried out on the vehicle and a new Engineers Certificate may be required. It is recommended that you retain the original and make copies of either the current electronic or pre-electronic versions. Always carry a copy together with your Rego Papers, Certificate of Operations, Current Club Membership and Log Book (for private use) and if questioned by an authorized person you must be able to supply the information regarding the modifications to tour vehicle
