Presidents Report – T Thompson

- * CVS Update 1608 vehicles, as at 31st May 2022.
- Reminder that CVS paperwork is not to be sent to CMC PO Box, it has its own PO Box address.
- * Road Safety Advisory Committee meeting has been held. Lots of information re road improvements planned. Road Deaths for the last 2 years is at the lowest since recording began. Partly because less people driving during Covid, but also cars getting safer. Highest death totals are not in the city, but for local people in regional towns.
- * Opening of Road Safety Week was held at the Opera House, with speakers such as "Sarah Foundation" telling their stories. This year's message "Everyone deserves to get home safely".
- * NSW now has 4 Ministers covering Transport, Rob Stokes, David Elliott, Sam Farraway and Natalie Ward.
- * Leeway allowance for speeding has been removed, any speeding can be fined.
- Issues still ongoing with a police officer and misinterpretation of forms. Multiple zoom meetings held with major 4 AO's, (CMC, ACMC, NSWHMA, & CHMC) re MOU – discussions continuing. We are asking for Clarification from TfNSW on the exact issues. Expected that the responsibility will be on the person signing the pink/blue slip paperwork. On agenda for upcoming HCCIWG meeting.
- * New number plates have now passed crash test. CVS are to be made smaller. New HVS plates will be rolled out as supplies are used up, they will be the same size. Not available yet, please do not go to Service NSW to ask.
- * Some Service NSW centres are processing Logbooks with the date of payment not the date of rego renewal, causing some people to have less days available. Please check your paperwork is correct prior to leaving the Service NSW centre.
- * AHMF AGM being held in September.
